- Made a motion to accept the quotes from Roselawn Electric one for \$1385.00 and another for \$1300.00 to repair electric lines damaged by Indian American Water, Deb seconded; vote taken; all approved none opposed, motion carried.
- ACC report: Mark informed us of 5 new homes to be built very soon. They are "Custom Homes," two are being built by Modern Family Builders, one by Clinton Jones, and one by Viking Homes, the fifth builder was not named.
